- PROCESS NOTES - for Source Processing Program

1.) Don't be surprised if the processes EP after one bracket of commands, especially the RRP 10, 11, 12, 13 ones. It may take a while to really get the question really answered, but when it is - you know it! On meter it would PTA, if not on meter you feel PTAing, VVGLs and CERTAIN of your KNOWLEDGE. (Calling the commands again after EP will produce a no-answer, no-interest phenomenon.)

2.) Allow some time between processes to write any new

cognitions or realizations down or experience any new abilities or perceptions. Sometimes these are not noticed until you go outdoors or "operate" a bit in life.

3.) Some may find they are on a "Source Mission" to do certain things here. If so, find out what the "EP" of the mission (or your part of it) is. Then plan to finish the cycle, as it probably is very valuable and important - or you wouldn't have gotten to this level so soon!
