After the C/O Cycle R/D at OT14, I had much better communication and understanding with the body. This relationship continued to improve as I and it went on up the bridge. To the point where it became a real working relationship with all kinds of day to day benefits such as less sleep needed, no illnesses, fast healing of any injuries and very much improved physical performance. The body is now, of its own free will, working with me to a common goal - ending the game and starting a better one.

I also began to comprehend, at OT14, what "getting one's power base" really means. I found that I could do in an hour or so what had taken a week or more at OT9.

The tech training was exciting too. As a student I was never asked to accept something blindly. The development and basis was always explained. I couldn't get away with glib answers I had to show that I understood

it so I would be able to apply the tech not just 'knew about' it.

It was difficult to believe that anything could surpass that but it did.

The three 'Games' levels, four 'fame' levels and VAST were simply incredible. The wins and cognitions kept on coming.
